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**We invite actors within the UN and civil society for a joint discussion on how a visualisation of the commitment to leave no one behind can spark discussions and actions to achieve the Global Goals for ALL.**

- How can we use 'Leave No One Behind' as an entry point in advocacy and dialogue?
- How do we best visualise the commitment?
- How can we use a visualisation to increase knowledge on who is being left behind and on actions needed to close the gaps?

### Background

To Leave No One Behind is one of the key challenges and commitments in the 2030 Agenda. No goal is considered met unless met for all. Through this commitment, we have promised to ensure that no one is left behind in development progress and to endeavour to reach the furthest behind first. This will require political will, participation, resources and data. It will also require communication and that we as a civil society hold our leaders accountable for this promise. We need to increase engagement and knowledge to ensure that this promise is fulfilled. We believe that a visualisation of Leave No One Behind can contribute to this.

In collaboration with New Division that has designed the icons for all the Sustainable Development Goals and their 169 targets, and with funding from Sida (the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency), CONCORD Sweden and Forum Syd aim to produce a visualisation for Leave No One Behind in the same visual language as the icons for the Global Goals and targets. The image will be an open source for everyone to use and we hope that this will facilitate communication and further highlight the commitment of the agenda. We plan for a social media launch ahead of the Global Summit.
